What Does the Fast Track Program Offer?

- Earn up to **6** hours of nursing-related dual credits while in high school.
 - Start nursing school at UCM a semester early by taking the correct dual credit/college while in high school (see suggestions on back.)
 - Work with a UCM advisor to plan out your path.
 - Practice critical thinking skills and become familiar with the NCLEX style of questions that you will use in nursing school and on the NCLEX-RN.
 - Learn new skills in the lab and collaborate nursing students currently in the nursing program at UCM.
- Meet UCM nursing professors and learn firsthand about the nursing program.
 - Opportunity to familiarize yourself and practice in a state-of-the-art nursing simulation center.
 - Learn about UCM's application process. Students attending STA's PNP will be awarded an extra point on their UCM nursing application.
 - Learn about the Direct Admission option offered only to current high school students who will be incoming UCM freshmen.
 - Qualify for the dual credit scholarship.
