

Four Year MIC Program Overview

Year 1: Junior Year

- Summer: students begin taking college classes (Metropolitan Community College)
- Fall: half a day at STA and half a day at home high school, possible evening/online college coursework (MCC)
- Spring: half a day at STA and half a day at home high school, possible evening/online college coursework (MCC)
- Resumé development/Interview preparation
- Tuition paid by MIC

Year 2: Senior Year

- Summer: Begin internship, ~40 hours per week, plus college coursework (MCC)
- Fall: Part time internship (2 days per week) plus college coursework (MCC)
- Spring: Part time internship (2 days per week) plus college coursework (MCC)
- Student does not go to home high school (eligible for extracurricular activities)
- Graduate high school in May
- Tuition paid by MIC

Year 3: First Year UCM (University of Central Missouri)

- Summer: Internship year two, ~40 hours per week, plus college coursework (MCC)
 - o Complete AAS degree from MCC
- Fall: Part time internship (2 days per week) plus college coursework (MCC/UCM-LS)
- Spring: Part time internship (2 days per week) plus college coursework (UCM-LS)

Year 4: Final Year UCM

- Summer: Internship year three, 40 hours per week, plus college coursework (UCM-LS)
- Fall: Part time internship (2 days per week) plus college coursework (UCM-LS)
- Spring: Part time internship (2 days per week) plus college coursework (UCM-LS)
- Graduate with Bachelor's Degree from UCM in May
